

I escaped from Bartow County Jail

My escape from Bartow County jail would be illegal if I was put there legally by law abiding police. I would like to take this opportunity to explain what influenced my decision to escape yesterday.

I had a bad experience with one of your deputies, Officer Strickland. Please allow me to explain the situation that your internal affairs system of 'inmate grievances' failed to resolve.

This all happened in one day, the 19th of October I believe. Deputy Strickland woke me up to confiscate my white T-Shirt. The deputy in charge of inmate dress in allowed me to have it and so did all the other deputies that saw me the first few days I was in custody, but deputy Strickland said that the two small black lines cause my shirt to be contraband according to the rule book. I gave him the shirt without any resistance or argument but I asked him to put the shirt into my property since it was the error of the booking deputy that allowed me to wear the white T-shirt into general population. Deputy Strickland told me that he would not return the shirt to my property, rather he was going to put it in the trash. I had no reply, but sometimes eye contact speaks more than words. I could not go back to sleep in your cold jail after such a rude awakening.

I went out to the dayroom and did pushups to stay warm. After exercising for a while I became hot and removed the blue denim top. Deputy Strickland saw me from the guard tower and came to punish me. Without any courtesy warning to your absurd rules that many deputies do not enforce, and despite the fact that I put the blue denim top back on when ordered to do so, deputy Strickland put me in an isolation cell for about 4 or 5 hours. The isolation cell was even colder than your jail and the hearts of many of your deputies. On the way to the isolation cell, Deputy Strickland provoked me. His exact words were, "If you look at me again, I'm going to take you to the ground". Is it illegal to have eye contact with a tyrant in Bartow County? I was not even allowed a mattress while in the isolation cell.

When Strickland returned to let me out, I looked him in the eyes. He told me that my punishment included 30 days loss of visitation privileges and loss of the right to purchase your overpriced food that is necessary to prevent starvation for someone with a high metabolism like myself. Michael Phelps eats a 20,000 calorie per day diet, mine is perhaps 3000 about twice that of the meals that you serve. After I was returned to my bunk I told a few inmates where I was all day, cleaned up, washed my face, brushed my teeth, and was the last person out the door for the dinner call. Deputy Strickland refused to allow me to eat dinner with the excuse that I was not fast enough to the door - even though I would not have held up the dinner routine.

I sat in the dorm alone during dinner and filed a grievance addressed to Gary Dover, the

person responsible for running the jail, I handed it to another deputy who delivered it to Strickland's supervisor, Sgt. Huskey. The grievance correctly stated that Deputy Strickland is a criminal due to his behavior. As a ward of the state it is your responsibility to keep me properly fed and clothed, Strickland intentionally kept me cold and hungry therefore he is a criminal according to the law.

After I filed the grievance I took a shower. Deputy Strickland came into the dorm and lifted the shower curtain exposing me to the other inmates and dropping my clothes on the wet floor. He refused to allow me to towel dry before handcuffing me; he did allow me to put pants on. He took me to Sgt. Huskey to witness how well your internal affairs policy works. Sgt. Huskey told me that the two little black lines caused my shirt to be contraband and he refused to deliver the grievance as it was addressed to Gary Dover. Sgt Huskey showed me the rule book that states a shirt must be white or grey and may not have any logos or letterings. He considered the two black lines to be a violation even though he did not see them himself, he praised Deputy Strickland for enforcing the rule that all the other deputies did not enforce. He confirmed my loss of visitation and food and had nothing to say about the threat to "take me to the ground" for improper eye contact or any of the other malicious behavior that Strickland displayed. Sgt Huskey is a criminal too because his job is to supervise his young officers so that they do not grow up to be tyrants.

While I was in your jail, I learned some disturbing facts about the senior tyrants and the Bartow County courts that hide their crimes. Brenton Garmon, previously a captain on your police force, and head of the Drug Task Force, as you know was convicted for stealing money and guns from drug dealers. The problem was in fact much larger than that - I'm sure you know. He also stole pounds of dope that he was never convicted for; mostly Meth but also Marijuana. Brenda Garmon then put the drugs back on the streets in the Chattanooga TN Drug Ring. This is the truth, but what I find most disturbing is how the Bartow County courts and District Attorney still cover his crimes today by causing all the cases with stolen evidence to sit idle until the statute of limitations expires so that the drug dealers do not win at trial because there is no evidence. They refuse to allow these cases to go to trial and one tactic used is to switch judges assigned to the case to help delay it.

Jesus called hypocrisy a heinous crime, referring to hypocrites as snakes and a brood of vipers. I call your pseudo-law enforcement organization a herd of pigs. Jesus said that all of Gods law is fulfilled if you obey this: "Love the Lord your God with all your heart, all your soul, and all your mind, and love your neighbor as yourself". I consider Jesus to be a legitimate authority and also Paul who put heavy emphasis on self control. You may be law enforcement officers, judges, and prosecutors in your eyes, but you are criminals in Gods eyes. You oppress the poor and pervert justice as a profession. I don't have the money to pay your unjust fines and even if I did I have other debts that I would pay first so behave yourself and get in line if you honestly believe I owe you money for something I did in Bartow County. Until then, the right thing would be for you to return my camera and the \$188 that I had in my pocket before I was abducted.

You punish me as you see fit, I'll see you all on judgment day. That's when we will learn why Bartow County has an abnormally high unsolved murder rate because everything done in the dark will be exposed for everyone to see.

I encourage you to read my thoughts on solving this problem by destroying police cars in the same spirit that the founders of our country destroyed tea in Boston:
